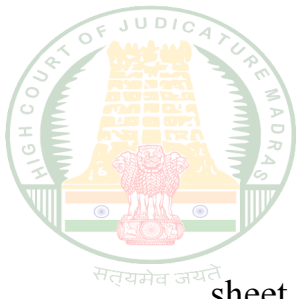

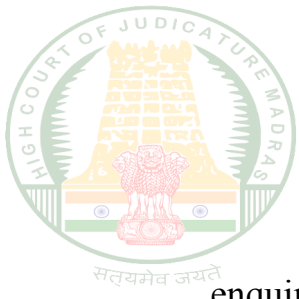

ORDER

3. Considering the limited scope of prayer sought for in this petition and recording the submissions of the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents that they will complete the



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enquiry within 15 days, this Court directs the third respondent to dispose of the representation of the petitioner, in accordance with law, within a period of 15 days from the date of this order.
