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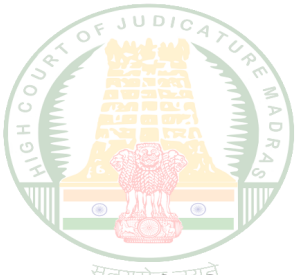

Prayer :-

Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the 1st and 3rd respondents to consider the application S. No.23, vide File No. A9/1244/2023 and to sanction and reissue the Cheque for the same amount released under Tamilnadu Government Accident Relief Scheme in name of all the legal heirs of the petitioners husband including herself and her two children separately on account of death of the petitioner husband namely Theen Tamilan, by considering the petitioners representation dated 20.01.2025 and 10.02.2025 in accordance with law within the time stipulated by this Honble Court.
