1 and 2 not to harass the petitioner under the guise of enquiry.

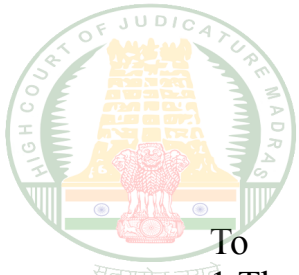
