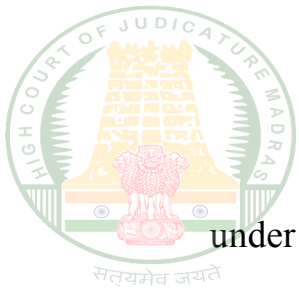

ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed to direct the Respondents 1 to 3 to give police protection to the petitioner from the respondents 4 and 5.

2.According to the petitioner, the petitioner is the owner of the property in old S.No.668/2 at Balakrishnapuram Village, Dindigul District. While so, the predecessors in title are demanding money from the petitioner. In this regard, there is a dispute between them. While so, the petitioner went to the subject property to fence and the same was restrained by the private respondents, hence he sent a representation before the respondents 1 to 3 on 16.02.2025 and the same has not been considered. Hence, this petition.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondents 1 to 3 would submit that there is a property dispute between the parties, hence the representation given by the petitioner is

under enquiry and they will complete the enquiry within a period of 1 week.

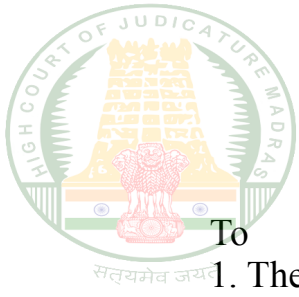
