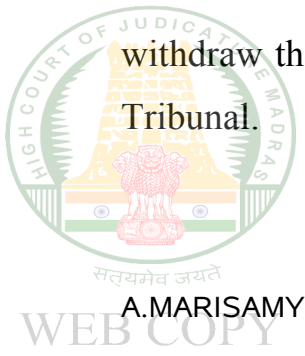

This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant/s PT.S.Narendravasan and the counsel for the respondent No.2 N.Dilip Kumar are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

Aggrieved by the Award passed by the Tribunal, the appellant / claimant has filed the present Appeal.

2. After due deliberations, both the parties have entered into compromise and agreed to enhance the award amount to a sum of Rs.13,00,000/- (Rupees Thirteen Lakhs only) with accrued interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum from the date of filing of the claim petition till realization. The 2nd respondent had already deposited a sum of Rs.14,75,000/- (Rupees Fourteen Lakhs and Seventy Five Thousand only) along with interest before the Tribunal. The 2nd respondent is directed to deposit the enhanced amount along with interest at the rate 7.5% per annum within a period of four weeks from the date of filing of the claim petition till realization, failing which the second respondent shall pay the Award amount together with interest at the rate of 7.5% per annum. The appellant is permitted to



withdraw the entire amount together with interest by filing formal application
