2.It is the grievance of the petitioner that his representation dated 05.02.2025, to take appropriate action to close the club bar functioning at 7th respondent individual Recreation Club namely “Friends Manamagizh Mandram FL.2” at Aranthangi, is kept pending till date without any progress. Therefore, he has filed this Writ Petition with the aforesaid prayer.

3.The learned Government Pleader appearing for the respondents 1 to 5 submits that the representation of the petitioner would be considered and appropriate orders would be passed on its own merits within a period that may be stipulated by this Court.

4.Considering the limited scope of the prayer sought for by the petitioner, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the claim made by the petitioner either in the representation or in the affidavit filed in support of this Writ Petition, we direct the first respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 05.02.2025, after giving sufficient opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and the seventh respondent and pass appropriate orders on merits and
