According to the petitioner, he lodged a complaint as against the unknown persons for the occurrence took place for the continuous threat made by them to evict the petitioner from the property in S.F.No.4795/1 to an extent of 40 grounds, Thallakulam. Hence this petition.

The learned Additional Public Prosecutor (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondents would submit that they received the representation of the petitioner dated 24.02.2025 and in the complaint, there is no mention about the names of the respondents. Therefore, the representation is under consideration and they will complete the enquiry within one week.

4. Since the prayer of the petitioner is to provide police protection, based on the representation dated 24.02.2025 and the same is under
