ORDER

This petition has been filed by the petitioner to call for the records pertaining to the First Information Report in Crime No.1794 of 2020 dated 17.12.2020 on the file of the first respondent police, for the offences under Section 379 of IPC and subsequently altered to Section 379 of IPC and Section 83(2) of Juvenile Justice Act and quash the same.

2. When the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned counsels on both sides represented that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and to that effect, they have entered into a compromise and the same was filed before this Court.

3. The defacto-complainant and the accused are present and this Court enquired about the terms of compromise. The defacto-complainant represented that they entered into a compromise and he has no objection



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to quash the FIR. A compromise memo, dated 26.03.2025 signed by the parties and their respective counsel, is also filed before this Court.

4. This Court has perused the terms of the compromise memo.

5. Considering the nature of the offences and the parties have also entered into a compromise, it is appropriate to allow this petition.

6. Recording the said compromise memo, this petition is allowed and the First Information Report in Crime No.1794 of 2020 dated 17.12.2020 on the file of the first respondent police is quashed as against the petitioner alone.
