By consent of both parties, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.

2.It is the grievance of the petitioner that his representation dated 12.03.2025 to take necessary steps immediately to demolish Jayaraj Nadar Mandapam, which is in unsafe condition and construct a new and safe building in its place, is kept pending till date without any progress. Therefore, he has filed this Writ Petition with the aforesaid prayer.

3.Mr.P.Thilak Kumar, learned Government Pleader takes notice for the 1st respondent and Mr.N.Dilip Kumar, learned Standing Counsel, who takes notice

for the 2nd respondent, submits that the representation of the petitioner would be considered and appropriate orders would be passed on its own merits within a period that may be stipulated by this Court.

4.Considering the limited scope of the prayer sought for by the petitioner, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the claim made by the petitioner either in the representation or in the affidavit filed in support of this Writ Petition, we direct the 2nd respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 12.03.2025, after giving sufficient opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period of twelve (12) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5.With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
