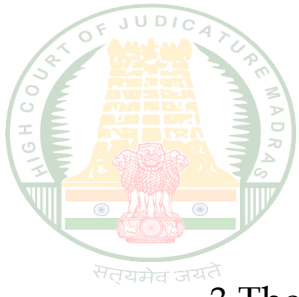
4.Hence, the Writ Petition stands dismissed.
