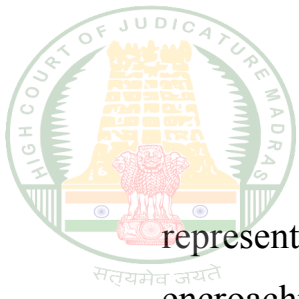

ORDER

[Order of the Court was made by *J.NISHA BANU, J.*]

By consent of both parties, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.

2.It is the grievance of the petitioner that her representation dated 27.02.2025 seeking removal of the encroachment made by the 5th respondent in S.No.26/1A2 situated at South Pethampatti, Karuvanoor Post, Kaavanoor Panchayat, Madurai District, is kept pending till date without any progress. Therefore, she has filed this Writ Petition with the aforesaid prayer.



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3.Mr.S.S.Madhavan, learned Additional Government Pleader takes notice for the respondents 1 and 2 and Mr.J.Ashok, learned Additional Government Pleader, who takes notice for the respondents 3 and 4, submits that the representation of the petitioner would be considered and appropriate orders would be passed on its own merits within a period that may be stipulated by this Court.

4.Notice to the 5th respondent is dispensed with, since no adverse order is going to be passed as against the 5th respondent.

5.Considering the limited scope of the prayer sought for by the petitioner, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the claim made by the petitioner either in the representation or in the affidavit filed in support of this Writ Petition, we direct the official respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 27.02.2025, after giving sufficient opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and the 5th respondent and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period of twelve (12) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.



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6. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
