For the sake of convenience, the parties herein are referred to as per the rank in Crl.R.C(MD)No.367 of 2025.

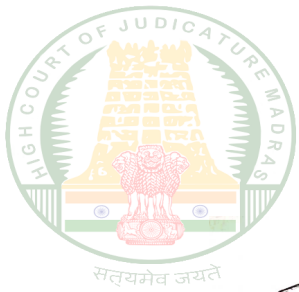
2. The revision petitioners have received all the Srithana articles including gold jewellery, house hold articles, Pongal Seer articles, dress materials and an amount of Rs.20,00,000/- as one time settlement is also paid by the respondent to the petitioners. The petitioners agreeing the same, have entered into a compromise and have also filed a satisfaction memo on their own volition. Parties are present before this Court. The 1st petitioner has also agreed to withdraw the cases in D.V.C.No.120 of



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2023 on the file of Additional Mahila Court, Tiruchirappalli and H.M.C.M.A.No.34 of 2024 on the file of I Additional District Court, Madurai.

3. Both the parties have agreed to file a petition for divorce by mutual consent on or before 16.07.2025 before the Family Court, Tiruchirappalli. The learned Family Court, Tiruchirappalli is directed to number the same within a period of 2 days from the filing of the petition and dispose of the same within a period of one (1) month thereafter. I appreciate the service rendered by the Commissioner Mr.Ganapathy Raman (1471/2004) Advocate for having taken hectic effort to resolve the issue between the couple involved. 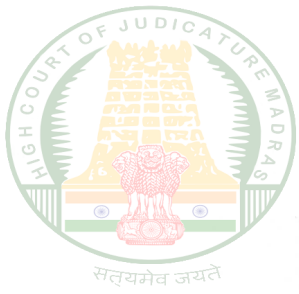

2. It is submitted that the entire rift between the 1st petitioner and the respondent arises out of the matrimonial dispute, wherein both the husband and wife have now arrived for an amicable settlement with the following terms:-

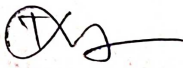
TERMS OF SETTLEMENT ARRIVED

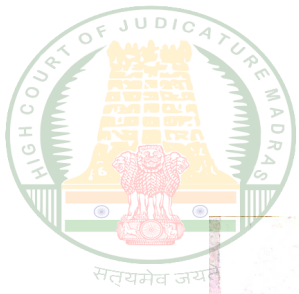
1. Both of us mutually agreed that the minor daughter Harshini shall be under the custody of the wife namely S.M.Ananthapriya, 1st petitioner in Crl.R.C.(MD)No.367 of 2025 /1st respondent in Crl.R.C.(MD)No.414 of 2025, the minor daughter namely Harshini shall be under the custody and care of the wife namely S.M.Ananthapriya, she will alone be the natural and legal guardian of the minor child.

2. The Respondent in Crl.R.C.(MD)No.367 of 2025 / Petitioner in Crl.R.C.(MD)No.414 of 2025, the minor child shall only with the wife namely S.M.Ananthapriya. Both of us mutually agreed that no visiting right to the husband namely T.Jagadeesh at any point of time.

3. The 1st Respondent, S.M. Anatha Priya, agreed to withdraw the following cases filed by her by recording this Joint Memo of Compromise entered in this Crl.R.C.(MD)Nos.367 & 414 of 2025:-

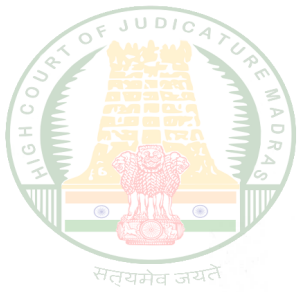

It is mutually agreed by both parties that the Petitioner/Husband Jagadeesh shall deposit a total sum of Rs.17,00,000/- (Rupees Seventeen Lakhs Only), which includes Rs.5,00,000/- (Rupees Five Lakhs Only) towards the value of the car bearing registration No.TN-55-BV-7817 and Rs.12,00,000/- (Rupees Twelve Lakhs Only) for the benefit of the minor daughter Harshini. In addition, a sum of Rs.3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakhs Only) (Remaining amount for the car) shall be deposited for the 1st respondent / wife in Indian Overseas Bank, Mathur Branch – 622515 in Account No.077701000012982, IFSC Code IOBA0000777 on 30.06.2025 in D.D.No.960799. The amount has been deposited as a fixed deposit in the name of the minor child in fixed deposit in Account No.077701000025417 in Indian Overseas Bank, Mathur Branch, IFSC Code IOBA0000777 for a sum of Rs.17,00,000/- (Rupees Twelve Lakhs Only) in Deposit Receipt No.0997559. Further the accrued interest will be kept in the minor's account at the Indian Overseas Bank, Mathur Branch. The minor child will be entitled to receive the interest periodically from the date of deposit i.e., on 07.07.2025 at I.O.B. Mathur Branch, Trichy and the said interest will be credited in the Account No.077701000012982, Indian Overseas Bank, Mathur Branch, Trichy was agreed by the Respondent Husband.

Both parties mutually agreed that the Petitioner/ Husband shall retain the TATA NEXON Car bearing Registration No.TN-55-BV-7817 in Engine No.1. 5CR05JYXW18137 and Chassis No.MAT627241MLK72878 with RC Book original registered in the name of the Petitioner / Respondent / Wife given as Srithana Property to the Respondent / Petitioner, and further, the 1st Petitioner / 1st Respondent handed over the Name Transfer Certificate Form duly signed by her for RTO Clearance on 07.07.2025.

8. Stem cell registration / details already registered by the Respondent / Petitioner namely T.Jegadeesh handed over to the Petitioner / 1st Respondent namely S.M.Ananthapriya today i.e., 11.07.2025.

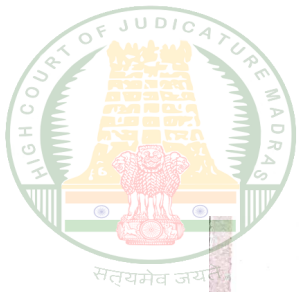
