When the matter was taken up for hearing today, it was brought to the notice of this Court that the investigation has been completed and police report has been filed in this case before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.V, Madurai and it has been taken on file in C.C.No.516 of 2024. In this police report, the petitioner has been arrayed as A2.

3. The entire submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner is based on the allegations made in the FIR. Now that stage has crossed and the police report has been filed. Therefore, the petitioner has
