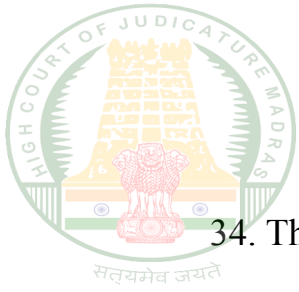

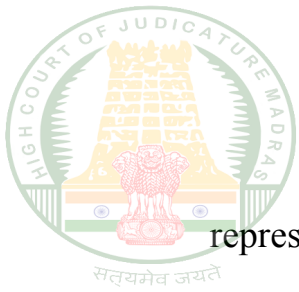

ORDER

This petition has been filed by the petitioners to call for the records pertaining to the First Information Report in Crime No. 5 of 2022 dated 07.01.2022 on the file of the first respondent police, for the offences under Sections 147, 148, 448, 380, 109 and 506(2) of IPC and Section 3 of TNPPDL Act and quash the same.

2. When the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned counsels on both sides represented that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and to that effect, they have entered into a compromise and the same was filed before this Court.

3. The defacto-complainant and all the accused are present and this Court enquired about the terms of compromise. The defacto-complainant



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represented that they entered into a compromise and he has no objection to quash the FIR. A compromise memo, dated 20.03.2025 signed by the parties and their respective counsel, is also filed before this Court.

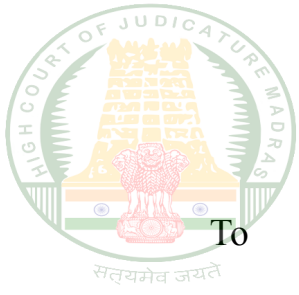
4. This Court has perused the terms of the compromise memo.
