PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to reclassify the land in S.No. 49/4B admeasuring 1.18.16 hectare situated at T.Andipatti Village, Alampatti, Thirumangalam Taluk, Madurai District as public pathway for usage of residents of Adi Dravidar Colony, T.Andipatti village which originally classified as Government Poramboke in the light



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of proceedings of the 4th respondent in Na.Ka.No. 2763/2023/E4 dated 25.04.2024 within a time stipulated by this Court.

ORDER

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4. The learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents would submit that the proposal is under consideration before the first respondent.

5. In view of the above, it would suffice to direct the first respondent shall pass orders on the petitioner's request for reclassification, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of. No costs.
