This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking a direction to the third respondent police not to harass the petitioner on the guise of enquiry based on the complaint given by the fourth respondent except in accordance with law.

2.When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police would submit that based on the complaint lodged by the fourth respondent, the respondent police called the petitioner for enquiry and thereafter, the main complaint itself was closed. The respondent police have not harassed the petitioner as alleged by him.
