ORDER

Heard Mr.M.Raghumankhan, learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr.J.Ashok, learned Additional Government Pleader for the respondents 1, 3 and 4 and Mr.K.Sivabalan, learned Standing Counsel, for the second respondent. Considering the nature of the order proposed to be passed in this writ petition, notice to the fifth respondent is dispensed with.

2.By consent, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.

3.The petitioner claims that he has sent a representation to the official respondents herein on 03.02.2025 seeking to remove the encroachment made in the petition mentioned property. But till today, the representation of the petitioner is kept pending without any progress.



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4.Considering the limited scope of the prayer sought for by the petitioner, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the claim made by the petitioner either in the representation or in the affidavit filed in support of the Writ Petition, this Writ Petition is **disposed of** with a direction to the fourth respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 03.02.2025 by giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as the fifth respondent and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period of twelve [12] weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order. No costs.
