ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking to quash the FIR in Crime No. 3 of 2025 on the file of second Respondent police and quash the same.

2.When the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) submitted that based on the complaint lodged by the third respondent, an FIR in crime No. 3 of 2025 has been registered, for the offences under Sections 191(2), 191(3), 126(2), 296(b), 351(3) of BNS r/w Section 3(1)(r) and 3(1)(s) of SC/St (POA) Act, 1989. After investigation, final report has been filed before the concerned Judicial Magistrate Court.

3.Since the prayer is to quash the FIR and now, the respondent



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police has already completed the investigation and filed final report and as per FIR, there are some allegations to constitute the offences, it is for the petitioners to challenge the final report if they are aggrieved.

4.In view of the same, preserving the liberty of the petitioners to challenge the final report in the manner known to law, this criminal original petition stands closed. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petition is also closed.
