PRAYER:Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus, to direct the respondents 1 to 3 herein to construct a Ration Shop (Fair Price Shop) in Survey No.15/8, situated at Ramaswamypuram, Ward-G, Block-16, Aruppukottai Taluk, Virudhunagar District as per Recommendation made by the Ministry of Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, by considering the petitioner's representation dated 28.02.2025 within the time stipulated by this Court.

But till today, the representation of the petitioner is kept pending without any progress.

4.Considering the limited scope of the prayer sought for by the petitioner, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the claim made by the petitioner either in the representation or in the affidavit filed in support of the Writ Petition, this Writ Petition is **disposed of** with a direction to the first respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 28.02.2025 by giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period of twelve [12] weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
