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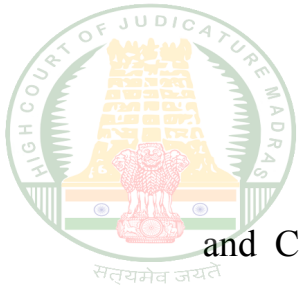

The defacto-complainant represented that they entered into a compromise as they are close relatives. A compromise memo, dated 01.04.2025 signed by the parties and their respective counsels, is also filed before this Court.

6. Considering the nature of the offences, the relationship between the parties and they have also entered into a compromise, it is appropriate to allow this petition.
