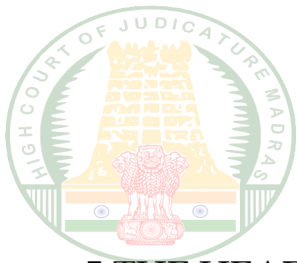

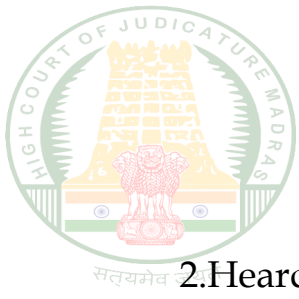
### ORDER
