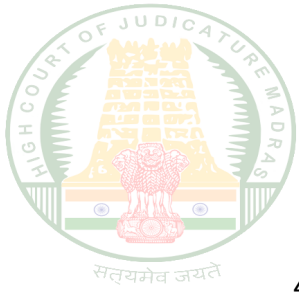

4. Learned Additional Government Pleader would submit that since the lands are classified as Government Tharisu lands, the approval of the first respondent would be necessary, before issuing patta to the petitioner, if otherwise, the petitioner is found to be entitled to the said patta.

5. Considering the above, the application of the petitioner dated 06.11.2023, shall be disposed of, by the fourth respondent, after getting necessary approval from the first respondent. The said exercise shall be concluded within a period of twelve [12] weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. Accordingly, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
