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ORDER

This petition is filed by the petitioner to quash the FIR in Crime No. 332 of 2021 on the file of the first respondent.

2. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) for the first respondent would submit that based on the complaint given by the second respondent, they conducted enquiry and filed the Final Report before the Trial Court and the same is pending for taking cognizance. There are some allegations to constitute the offence as against the petitioner. Hence, nothing survives for further adjudication in this petition.

3. Considering the prayer sought for in this petition, this Court, without issuing notice to the second respondent, is inclined to pass orders.

4. The prayer of the petitioner is to quash the FIR in Crime No.332 of 2021, however the first respondent completed the investigation and also filed the Final Report and even as per the FIR, there are some



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allegations to constitute the offence against the petitioner. Hence, it is for the petitioner to challenge the Final Report in the manner known to law, if he is aggrieved.

5. In view of the same, recording the submission of the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side), this Criminal Original Petition is closed, with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the Final Report in the manner known to law, if he is aggrieved. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
