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ORDER

This petition has been filed by the petitioner to quash the First Information Report in Crime No.41 of 2025 dated 01.02.2025 on the file of the first respondent police, for the offences under Sections 329(4), 296(b), 118(1), 324(4) and 351(3) of BNS Act, 2023 and Section 4 of the TN Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, 2002.

2. When the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned counsel on both sides represented that the matter has also been amicably settled between the parties and to that effect, they have entered into a compromise and the same was filed before this Court.

3. The defacto-complainant and the petitioner are present and this Court enquired about the terms of compromise. The defacto-complainant represented that they entered into a compromise as they are close relatives and she has no objection to quash the FIR. A compromise memo, dated 21.03.2025 signed by the parties and their respective counsel, is also filed before this Court.

4. This Court has perused the terms of the compromise memo.



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5. Considering the nature of the offences and the relationship between the parties and they have also entered into a compromise, it is appropriate to allow this petition.

6. Recording the said compromise memo, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and the First Information Report in Crime No.41 of 2025 dated 01.02.2025 on the file of the first respondent police is quashed. The compromise memo dated 21.03.2025 filed by the parties shall form part of this order.
