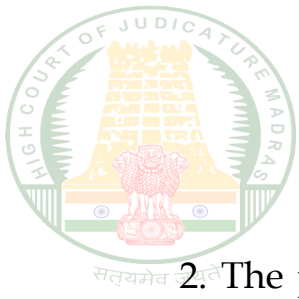

PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS, 2023
PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.149 of 2025 on the file of the respondent-police.
ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed by the petitioner on 27.03.2025 under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS), 2023, praying to grant an order of pre-arrest bail.



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2. The petitioner apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent-police for the offences punishable under Sections 191(2), 118(1), 303(1) and 351(3) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023, in Crime No.149 of 2025 on the file of the respondent-police.

3. The case of the prosecution is that on 17.03.2025, at about 03.30 p.m., when the defacto complainant was standing near James & Co., Kallal Raod, the accused persons came there and caused injury on the hands of the defacto complainant by using broken glass and threatened him with dire consequences. They forcibly obtained a signature in a document and also took the defacto complainant's friend's Xylo Car bearing Registration No.TN 02 AJ 2323. Hence, the case.

4. Mr.G.R.Satish, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner did not commit any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submits that the petitioner and the defacto complainant are having money transaction and the defacto complainant falsely lodged a complaint against the petitioner and other accused persons. He however submits that the petitioner is ready to abide by any conditions to be imposed by this Court. Hence, he prays for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner.

5. Per contra, Mr.S.S.Manoj, learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent-police, on instructions, submits that the petitioner



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appeared before the respondent-Police and co-operated with the investigation and has also given a statement. He further submits that during investigation, it transpired that the petitioner and the defacto complainant are having money transaction. He further submits that considering the nature of the case, custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not necessary for the investigation agency.

6. Heard on both sides. This Court has perused the records.

7. In view of the submissions made by the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) and considering the fact that the petitioner has permanent residence and deep roots in the Society due to which there is less possibility of absconding and with a view to give an opportunity to the petitioner to reform himself, this Court is inclined to grant an order of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions:

(i) The petitioner shall be released on bail in the event of his arrest or in the event of his surrender before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Sivagangai, within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy is made ready, on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) along with two sureties each for a like sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Sivagangai;

(ii) The sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the



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Application for Suretyship [Judicial Form No.46 annexed to 'The Criminal Rules of Practice, 2019']. The learned Judicial Magistrate shall obtain a copy of any one of identity proofs to ensure their identity;

(iii) The petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;

(iv) The petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;

(v) The petitioner shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court;

(vi) Thereafter, the petitioner shall appear and sign before the respondent-Police weekly twice i.e., on every Sunday and Friday at 10.30 a.m. until further orders;

(vii) The petitioner shall furnish his residential address and mobile number to the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Sivagangai;

(viii) The petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, cause any threat to the defacto complainant and witnesses and shall not tamper the evidence; and

(ix) On breach of any of the aforementioned conditions, concerned Magistrate, or Trial Court as the case may be, is entitled to pass appropriate orders against the



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petitioner in accordance with law as if the aforementioned conditions are imposed
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by them as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K. Shaji vs. State of Kerala
[(2005) 13 SCC 283].

8. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed subject to the conditions stated supra.
