ORDER

This petition is filed by the petitioners to quash the FIR in Crime No27 of 2025 on the file of the first respondent.

2. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) for the first respondent would submit that based on the complaint given by the second respondent, they conducted enquiry and filed the Final Report. There are some allegations to constitute the offence as against the petitioners. Hence, nothing survives for further adjudication in this petition.

3. Considering the prayer sought for in this petition, this Court, without issuing notice to the second respondent, is inclined to pass orders.

4. 4. The prayer of the petitioners is to quash the FIR in Crime No.27 of 2025, however the first respondent completed the investigation and also filed the Final Report and even as per the FIR, there are some



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allegations to constitute the offence against the petitioners. Hence, it is for the petitioners to challenge the Final Report in the manner known to law, if they are aggrieved.

5. In view of the same, recording the submission of the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side), this Criminal Original Petition is closed, preserving the liberty of the petitioners to challenge the Final Report in the manner known to law, if they are aggrieved. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
