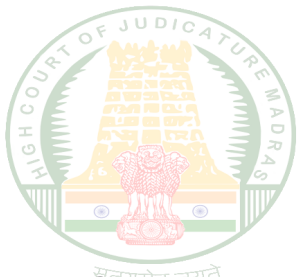
This Civil Miscellaneous Petition is filed under section 5 of Limitation Act to condone the delay of 29 days to filing the review application

"Mr.S.Snehan Kandasamy, learned counsel representing Mr.M.Shakul Hameed, learned counsel for the petitioner on record seeks permission of this Court to withdraw this miscellaneous petition.

2.However, it is unnecessarily opposed by the learned counsel for the 1st respondent on the ground that the petitioner had disobeyed the interim order granted by this Court which is sought to be reviewed.

3.This Court finds no merit in the objection raised by the learned counsel for the 1st respondent. If the petitioner has committed willful disobedience of the order passed by this Court earlier, it is open to the 1st respondent to prosecute the petitioner for contempt.
