### **ORDER**

This petition has been filed by the petitioners to call for the records pertaining to C.C.No.1520 of 2024, on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.III, Tirunelveli, for the offences under Sections 294(b), 147 and 506(i) of IPC, in Crime No.176 of 2024 and quash the same.

2. According to the petitioners, based on the complaint given by the defacto complainant, the police has registered FIR in Cr.No. 176 of 2024 for the offences under Sections 294(b), 147 and 506(i) of IPC.
