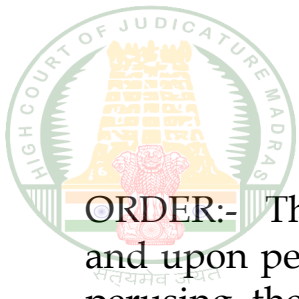

Jeganathan, Advocate for the Petitioner and of Thiru. M.Karunanithi, Government Advocate for the 1st and 2nd respondents, this Court made the following order:

This petition has been filed seeking to amend the trial Court as learned Principal and District Sessions Judge, Special Court for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (Amended 2015), **Madurai**.

2.The learned Counsel for the petitioner would submit that in the prayer portion and in paragraph No.4 of the order copy, the trial Court is wrongly mentioned as the learned Principal and District Sessions Judge, Special Court for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (Amended 2015), **Theni** instead of learned Principal and District Sessions Judge, Special Court for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (Amended 2015), **Madurai**.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police also admitted that the FIR has been registered only by the second respondent and the same is pending with him. Therefore, the competent jurisdictional court is learned Principal and District Sessions Judge, Special Court for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (Amended 2015), **Madurai**.



4. In view of the submission made by the respondent police, this petition is ordered.

5. Registry is directed to carry out necessary amendment as prayed for and issue a fresh order copy.

6. The time already granted by this Court in the main petition is extended for another fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
