2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner lodged a complaint against the respondents 3 to 5 before the second respondent on 04.11.2024 and thereby, the second respondent assigned C.S.R.No.35 of 2025, but no any action was taken. Therefore, he filed this petition.

3. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor (Crl.Side) for the respondents 1 and 2 would submit that the petitioner lodged a complaint and they assigned C.S.R.No.35 of 2025 and the same is pending on enquiry. Further, they will conduct enquiry and dispose of the same within

one week.

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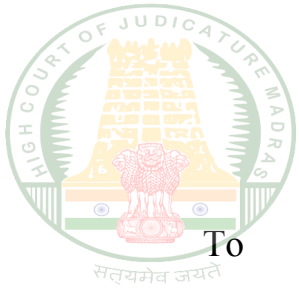
4. Considering the prayer sought for in this petition, this Court, without issuing notice to the private respondents, is inclined to pass orders.
