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2.A perusal of the records reveal that the Second Appeal filed by the defendant in S.A.(MD)No.6 of 2021, has been dismissed by this Court on 21.10.2024. The defendant seeks time to produce the order copy. Hence, the executing Court is not in a position to pass orders. In the above said circumstances, the present revision petition has been filed.
