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The Civil Miscellaneous Petition has been filed seeking orders to condone the delay of 48 days in filing the appeal against the judgment and decree, dated 28.06.2024 in A.S.No.25 of 2023 on the file of the I Additional Sub Court, Madurai, confirming the judgment and decree, dated 10.02.2023 in O.S.No.59 of 2009 on the file of the District Munsif Court, Vadipatti.

2.Despite receipt of notice, the second respondent has not turned up.

3.Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, learned counsel for the first respondent and also perused the records.

4.The learned counsel for the first respondent would submit that they are not having any objections to allow this petition.

5.Considering the reasons assigned and also taking note of the quantum of delay, this Court is inclined to condone the delay. Accordingly, this petition is ordered and the Registry is directed to take the appeal on file, if it is otherwise in order and list the matter in the usual course.
