ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

This petition has been filed to permit the petitioner to intervene in the above bail petition in CrI.O.P.(MD).No.20029 of 2024 and prays for the dismissal of the bail.

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners and the learned counsel appearing for the first respondent/Sole Accused.

3.It is submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the first respondent that the entire amount has been settled to the petitioners 2 and 3.

4. As far as the first petitioner is concerned, the first respondent submitted that the first petitioner is entitled to Rs.5,00,000/- as per the statement of accounts. Further first petitioner has borrowed Rs.2,48,000/- and he has to repay the same. Hence the first respondent submitted he is ready to pay the balance amount of Rs.3,10,000/- to the first petitioner.



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5. Accepting the said contention, the first respondent is directed to pay Rs.3,10,000/- to the petitioner. As far as the balance amount of Rs.2,48,000/- is concerned, the first petitioner is at liberty to approach the appropriate Civil Court / arbitration, whichever is available.
