This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant/s Mr.J.S.Murali and the counsel for the 1st respondent Mr.D.Boopal and the counsel for the 3rd respondent Mr.T.Lenin Kumar are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for



settlement.

AWARD

Aggrieved by the award passed by the Tribunal, the appellants / Insurance Company have filed the present appeal.

2. After due deliberations, both the parties have entered into compromise and agreed to settle the award amount to a sum of Rs.21,50,000/- (Rupees Twenty One Lakhs and Fifty Thousand only) with interest at the rate of 7.5 % per annum from the date of claim petition till the date of realization and costs. The appellants are directed to deposit the aforesaid award amount, after deducting the amount already deposited, if any, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this award. On such deposit being made, the 1st respondent is permitted to withdraw the amount by filing formal application before the Tribunal. The appellants / Insurance Company are permitted to withdraw the excess amount, if any, by filing formal application before the Tribunal.
