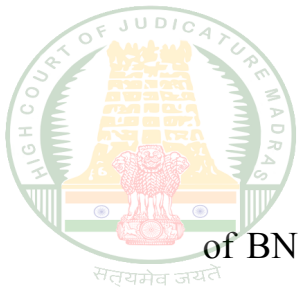

ORDER

This petition is filed by the petitioner to transfer the case in Crime No.48 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police and to entrust the investigation to the fourth respondent or some other competent officer.

2. Today when the matter is taken up for admission, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor (Crl.Side) for the respondents would submit that based on the complaint lodged by the petitioner, they registered a case in Crime No.48 of 2025 for the offences under Sections 296(b) and 115(2)



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of BNS and thereafter, closed the case as mistake of fact and notice also served to the petitioner. Therefore, the transfer of investigation would not arise in this case.

3. Considering the prayer sought for in this petitioner and the investigation was already completed and closed as mistake of fact after serving notice to the petitioner, therefore it is for the petitioner to challenge the closure report in the manner known to law.

4. In view of the same, the transfer of investigation would not arise. However, the petitioner is at liberty to approach the learned Judicial Magistrate-I, Ramnad to challenge the closure report of the complaint in the manner known to law.

5. With the abovesaid liberty, this Writ Petition is closed.
