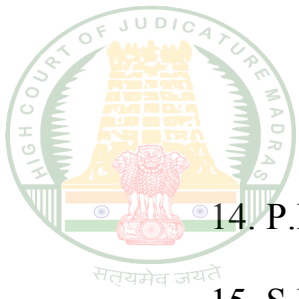

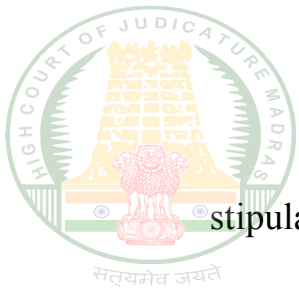

This petition is filed by the petitioner to direct the learned Judicial Magistrate, Melur to dispose of the case in C.C.No.53 of 2021 within

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2. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is the *defacto* complainant in this case. He lodged a complaint against the respondents and the same is taken on file by the Trial Court in C.C.No.53 of 2021. The occurrence took place in the year 2016.
