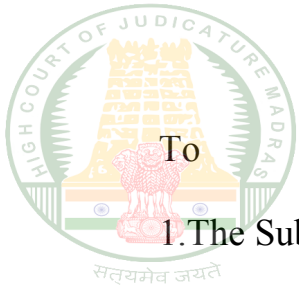
2. Accordingly, the Civil Revision Petition stands dismissed as infructuous. No costs. Consequently, the connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
