By consent, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

2.Heard Mr.J.Jeevin, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr.P.Thilak Kumar, learned Government Pleader for the respondents 1 to 4 and Mr.A.Albert James, learned Government Advocate for the fifth respondent.

3.The writ petition was filed challenging the proceedings issued by the second respondent dated 08.04.2025, thereby granting permission for 24*7

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movement of boulders to work site at Neerodi and exemption from regular check up of 86 vehicles permission.

4.When the writ petition is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Pleader appearing for the respondents 1 to 4, on instructions, submits that the order impugned in this writ petition itself has been cancelled vide proceedings in Rc.No.113/G&M/2025, dated 12.04.2025.

5.In view of the above, the prayer sought for in this writ petition has become infructuous. Accordingly, this writ petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
