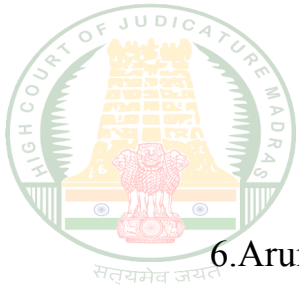

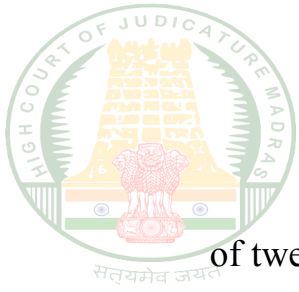

4.The learned Government Pleader appearing on behalf of the official respondents submits that the representations of the petitioner would be considered and appropriate orders would be passed in accordance with law within a period that may be stipulated by this Court.

5.Considering the limited scope of the prayer sought for by the petitioner, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the claim made by the petitioner either in the representation or in the affidavit filed in support of the Writ Petition, this Writ Petition is **disposed of** with a direction to the fifth respondent to consider the representations of the petitioner dated 20.01.2024 and 25.11.2024 by giving an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner as well as the sixth respondent and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period
