2.According to the petitioner, the petitioner is the defacto complainant in this case. Based on the complaint of the petitioner, a case has been registered by the respondent police in Cr.No.353 of 2024 against the accused persons. After filing of final report, it has been taken cognizance in PRC No.38 of 2025. Therefore, seeks for speedy disposal and this petition has been filed.

3.The learned Government Advocate (CrI.Side) would submit that based on the complaint of the petitioner, a case has been



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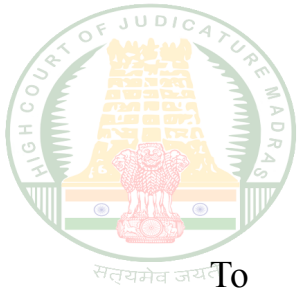
