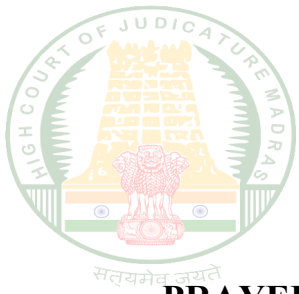

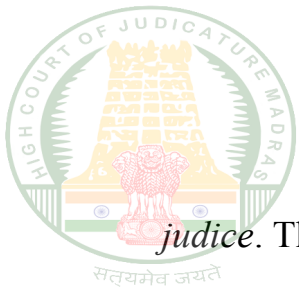

ORDER

(Order of the Court was made by ***S.M.SUBRAMANIAM, J.***)

The relief sought for in the present writ petition is to direct the respondents to take action against the private pay channels which are airing advertisements and ban the same which are against the TRAI Rules and Regulations on the basis of the Petitioner representation dated 29/1/2019.

2. Regarding the issue raised in the present writ petition, the High Court of Delhi granted an interim stay in W.P(C).7982/2013 and that writ petition is *sub*



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judice. Thus, no further adjudication at this juncture needs to be undertaken. If any grievance arose after disposal of the case before the Delhi High Court, the petitioner is at liberty to do so.

3. In view of the above, the writ petition is disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
