On receipt of the said representation from the petitioner, the District Revenue Officer, Virudhunagar, shall consider the same on merits and in accordance with law, after affording an opportunity to the petitioner and pass final orders within a period of twelve weeks thereafter.

5. With the above direction, this writ petition is disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
