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this order, after affording opportunity to both the parties.

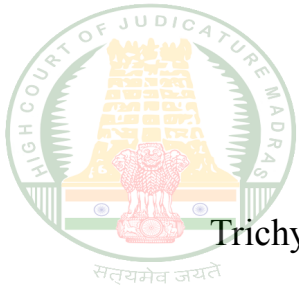
