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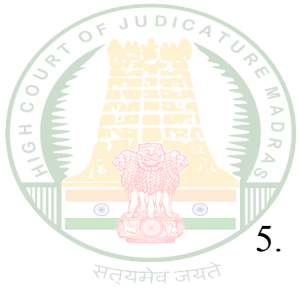
ORDER

In view of the above, the order impugned in the writ petition, dated 14.03.2025 is set aside and the matter is remitted to the respondent to give an opportunity to the petitioner and thereafter, dispose of the petitioner's application, on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of twelve (12) weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.



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5. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is allowed. No costs.
