**Communication Engineering in Government Polytechnic Colleges for the year 2018-19.** Further, G.O(Ms)No.71, Higher Education (12) Department, dated 26.02.2021 has also been passed, wherein the Government has approved the regular panel for the post of Head of Department/Electronics and Communication Engineering in Government Polytechnic Colleges for the year 2018-19 consisting the names of 18 Lecturers.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that liberty may be granted to the petitioner to challenge the subsequent orders passed by the Government.

4. In view of the above, this Writ Petition stands dismissed. The writ petitioner is at liberty to challenge the subsequent adverse Orders, if any, passed by the Government, in a manner known to law. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petitions are closed.
