PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to immediately remove all encroachments obstructing Muthuramalinga Street located in Ward No.12, Block No.2, Town Survey No.81, Madurai North, Madurai Corporation, to restore the

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original width of the road by considering the petitioner's representation dated 24.03.2025 within the time frame stipulated by this Court.

ORDER

By consent of both parties, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.

2.It is the grievance of the petitioner that his representation dated 24.03.2025, seeking removal of the encroachments by obstructing Muthuramalinga Street located in Ward No.12, Block No.2, Town Survey No.81, Madurai North, Madurai Corporation and to restore the original width of the road, is kept pending till date without any progress. Therefore, he has filed this Writ Petition.

3.Mr.P.Thilak Kumar, learned Government Pleader, who takes notice on behalf of the 1st respondent, submits that the representation of the petitioner would



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be considered and appropriate orders would be passed in accordance with law within a period that may be stipulated by this Court.

4.Mr.S.Vidhyasagar, learned counsel takes notice for the respondents 2 to 4.

5.Considering the limited scope of the prayer sought for by the petitioner, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the claim made by the petitioner either in the representation or in the affidavit filed in support of this Writ Petition, we direct the 1st respondent to consider the representation of the petitioner dated 24.03.2025, after giving sufficient opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period of twelve (12) weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6.With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
