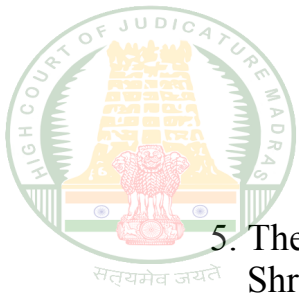

3 The writ petitions stands disposed of with the above observations.

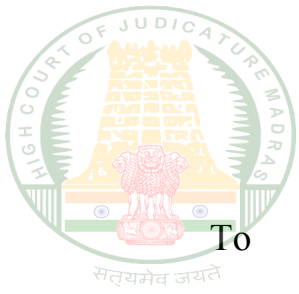
