ORDER

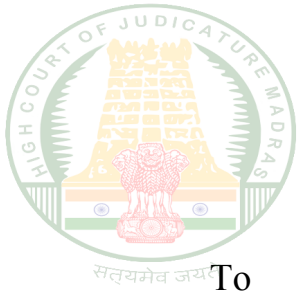
(Order of the Court was made by S.M.SUBRAMANIAM, J.)
