## **ORDER**

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This Criminal Original Petition has been filed to direct the respondents to provide an adequate police protection to the petitioner and her family members life and limb as well as the property by considering the petitioner's representation dated 25.03.2025.

2.According to the petitioner, due to property dispute, the private party caused threat to the petitioner without any rights, therefore, the petitioner sent a representation dated 25.03.2025, but the same has not been considered. Hence this petition.

3.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police would submit that the petitioner's representation is under consideration and they will consider the same and take appropriate action, in accordance with law, within a period of 15 days.

4.Considering the limited scope of the prayer sought for in this petition, this Court, without even issuing notice to the private respondent, is inclined to pass order.

5.Considering the prayer of the petitioner and the second respondent also admitted the receipt of the petitioner's representation, it is for the 2<sup>nd</sup> to take appropriate action in accordance with law.

6.In view of the above, this Court is directs the 2<sup>nd</sup> respondent to conduct enquiry on the petitioner's representation and take appropriate action within a period of 15 days from the date of this order, after affording opportunity to both the parties, in accordance with law.

7.With the above directions, this Criminal Original petition is disposed of.
