Therefore, he has filed this Writ Petition.

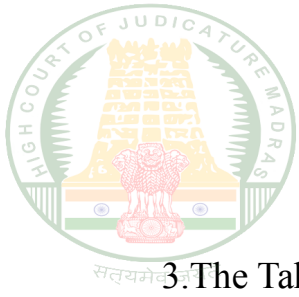
